

Vote This June !

HERE'S HOW:

- Get your application for an absentee ballot:
 - Every New York registered voter will be mailed an absentee ballot application at the address where they are registered or;
 - Download the [application here](#) or;
 - NYC voters can [apply online here](https://nycabsentee.com/) : <https://nycabsentee.com/> or;
 - Call the BOE here: 1-866-868-3692
- Fill out the application - Follow the instructions:
 - Check the "Temporary Illness or Physical disability" box
 - Put in the address where you would like to get a ballot where it says "Delivery of Primary Election Ballot"
- Submit the application (if you didn't use the online form)
 - Mail your application to the BOE: 200 Varick Street, 10 Fl, New York, NY 10014
 - Email the application to AbsenteeJune2020@boe.nyc
- **VOTE!**
 - Mark you ballot, fold it and put it in the small envelope
 - Sign and date the back of the envelope,
 - Seal the smaller envelope and place it in the larger envelope,
 - Put it in the mail!

IMPORTANT DATES AND DEADLINES:

- Primary Election Day: Tuesday June 23rd
 - Registration Deadline for New Voters: Friday May 29th
 - Change of address Deadline: Wednesday June 3rd
 - Deadline to Submit Absentee Applications: Tuesday June 16th

Student Absentee Voting FAQ

Why should we vote absentee this June?

To maintain social distancing during COVID-19 and reduce lines at the polls, Gov Cuomo ordered that every New Yorker can vote absentee and will be sent an application for an absentee ballot. Check "Temporary Illness or Disability" on the application.

I'm not at the address where I'm registered, what should I do? Especially For On Campus Registrants!

Fill out an application for an absentee ballot online using either this form: <https://nycabsentee.com/> or download an application and then mail/email it to your local BOE. Include the address where you would like to receive a ballot on the application

What am I voting for?

Congressional, state and local primaries are still on! They decide everything from CUNY/SUNY funding to make sure we all have access to clean water! You can find out who's on your ballot [here](#)

Will polling places be open?

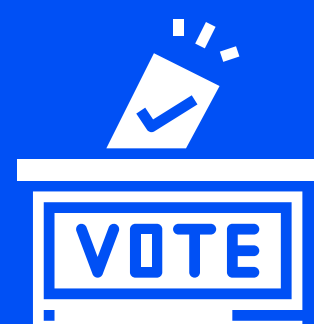
Yes. But consider voting absentee to maintain social distancing.
